

Intensive Driving Courses - Fast Pass

By now you will have contacted Fast Pass to know more about Intensive Driving Courses

Things you need to know:

- Intensive courses usually involve weekdays - for example 20 hours per week, Monday to Friday.
- There is a £100 deposit to reserve the course (refundable with 2 weeks prior notice of course cancellation)
- Balance of courses is payable on first day
- Liaise with instructor regarding availability and times
- You will receive a list of days and times before paying your deposit
- Deposit is paid to Instructor usually by bank transfer
- Your instructor will give you a time and date to attempt to book a test for, this is usually the pupils responsibility due to the difficulty being able to use a phone during the working day. It also gives the pupil flexibility when a preferred date is not available in choosing another option which suits them. Or to keep checking back in order to get the preferred date. People cancel tests all the time and the computer system is updated every 15 minutes, so a night spend looking for a cancellation usually works out.

There is usually a waiting time of around 2 weeks for the theory test and 4-6 weeks for the practical test

If you cannot get a test for the required date please follow the following steps:

- Book a test for the next available date after the preferred option
- Check back regularly to move the date forward to the preferred date - in conjunction with your driving instructors availability
- Remember you can only change the date 6 times for free and must give 3 full working days notice. More info <https://www.gov.uk/change-driving-test>
